

Instructions

1. Sign up for [Heroku](#)
2. Install [Heroku Command Line](#)
3. Log into the toolbelt from the terminal:

```
$ heroku login
```

4. Create a project with at least an `index.html` file:

```
<html>
  <header><title>Hello World</title></header>
  <body>
    Hello world
  </body>
</html>
```

5. Add an `index.php` file:

```
<?php include_once("index.html"); ?>
```

6. Create an empty Git repository:

```
$ git init
```

7. Create a Heroku app (note the app URL):

```
$ heroku create
```

8. Add and commit changes:

```
$ git add .  
$ git commit -m "Create hello world webpage"
```

9. Push changes to Heroku, just like you push them to GitHub: `$ git push heroku master`

Cool tricks:

- Open the current app in your browser:

```
$ heroku open
```

- Watch the logs in real time:

```
$ heroku logs -t
```

- Push other branches to Heroku (for testing):

```
$ git push heroku yourbranch:master
```
